





CROSS-BORDER OPERATION FROM TURKIYE TO NWS (from 01 Jan 2024 to 27 August 2024)7












NUMBER OF TRUCKS CROSSED PER MONTH BY BORDER CROSSING POINT(as of 27 August 2024)7


